Ph.D. Course-Work - 2017

Applications are invited from eligible candidates, duly approved by Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University- Research & Recognition (RRC) Committee; in the Faculty of Social Sciences, for the admission to Pre-Ph.D. Course-Work – May, 2017.

Interested candidates may enroll themselves, after duly filling the Enrollment / Admission Form, along with Fee Receipt & Documents; & submit it to The Head, Department of Political Science, Dr.Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad; on or before 24th April, 2017.

The rules for the same are as under -

- 1. Qualified M.Phil. Students from Recognized Universities are exempted from the Course-Work,
- Mere submission of the Application Form (& other formalities) shall not confirm the admission of the candidate to the Course. The Department reserves the right to select & admit the candidates to the course-work.
- 3. **90% of the attendance is a mandate**; failing which, the participant / candidate shall be deemed to have voluntarily withdrawn the participation / admission from the Coursework,
- 4. The teaching method, shall be a mix of theory, practice & seminars as prescribed by the Appropriate Authority. The participants are required to participate actively in each of those, with complete adherence to the norms,
- 5. Seats are limited, for to enhance the impact of the course. No requests or applications shall be entertained after the required number of enrollments / registration deadline whichever is earlier;
- 6. Registration Fee for the Coursework is Rs.2000/- for Indian Nationals & Rs.10,000/- for Foreign Nationals.
